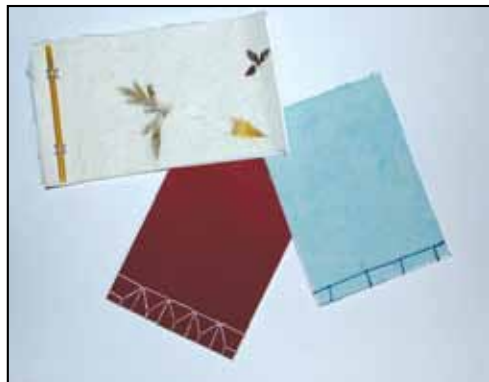

Japanese Stab Binding



In this creative afternoon we will make little notebooks using attractive and simple stitching techniques in the Japanese style. You don't need to have any special sewing skills and they can be individualised by using coloured threads and bright beads, different stitching styles and decorated paper for the covers. Papermaking

Using high quality pulp made from recycled materials explore different papermaking techniques. You will work towards creating gift tags for a multitude of uses over the festive season and/or

a bi-fold gift card. The latter is designed to hold any denomination of money note for giving in that 'old school' style so bring along a note to be shown the secret of how to secure it. Incorporate some seeds into your pulp for extra effect, either by bringing your own from your favourite plant or use those provided.

Macramé



Make a ready to hang 75 cm long macramé plant hanger, suitable for a medium size plant pot or glass bowl. Learn the basic macramé knots which are simple but can be used to great effect for the design of different hangers in your own time. Provided materials include rope, beads, hanging ring and take home instructions.

Linoprinting



Linocuts are a simple way to start printmaking, but you need to practise with the right tools and know which types of lino to use to get the best results. Bring ideas about what designs you might like to try (sample designs provided to get you started) and protective clothing (eg old shirt).

Mixed Media Journal or Needlecase Cover



Use scraps of fabrics and papers, with paints, stencils and heat-activated puff-paint to create a beautiful textured cover for a small art journal, diary, or needle case. There will be an option to add machine or hand stitching. Suitable for beginners or those with some textiles experience. Familiarity with using a sewing machine for simple straight and zigzag stitching would be useful, but is not essential, using shared sewing machines. **NB:** Please bring a small pocket-sized notebook or diary to cover (maximum size 12 x 15 cm or 9 x 18 cm). **Optional:** BYO sewing machine if you would like to decorate with pattern stitches or free machine embroidery.

Rope Basket Making



Sew a basket from cotton rope using zigzag stitch. Once you have mastered the skill there are many options, from baskets and bowls, to totes, platters, place mats, beach bags and dog baskets.

You are likely to complete a 22 cm basket in the session. A decent sewing machine with adjustable zigzag stitch and basic sewing machine skills are required. Other than your sewing machine, you will need to bring scissors, tape measure and pins, and an empty bobbin. All other materials and references to supplies are provided. Arrive 15 minutes early to set up.
