SELECTION INFORMATION

GIFT SHOP, ARTIST OF THE MONTH and HOSTED EXHIBITIONS

Pepper Street Arts Centre (PSAC) invites new artists to contribute to exhibition, gift shop and artist of the month programs. Established, hobbyist and emerging artists are all welcome.

All artworks are subject to a selection process for the following areas:

Exhibitions: The exhibition space is available for hire for group shows and individual artists. **For more information on the hire of this space and to obtain a separate application form please see staff.**

Hosted exhibitions: PSAC organises and hosts a couple of mixed media exhibitions a year for the benefit of all artists who wish to apply. These are typically for the Adelaide Fringe Festival, South Australian Living Artists Festival (SALA) and Little Treasures (Christmas show). For more information on the theme and timeline of these exhibitions please refer to the website or *Pepper Newsletter*. Each artist selected to exhibit will be required to pay a small exhibition fee (the amount varies depending on the exhibition).

Gift Shop: Local artists who specialise in high quality and affordable art & craft are welcome to submit for inclusion in the gift shop.

Artist of the Month: A featured area at the entrance of the gift shop is provided to highlight a new range of works by new and continuing artists with a new range, primarily suited to 3D artworks. Some 2D will be considered.

The selection panel is a group of experienced, local artists and craftspeople. Please note that this panel meets independently of your submission and selects work only, they are not required to critique or give feedback.

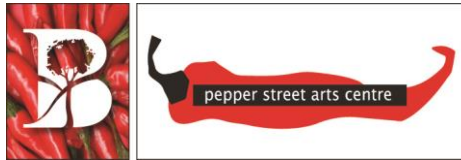
Commission is 33% including GST (on commission only); excluding ongoing volunteers (22%).

Insurance is not provided for your work until it has been accepted and processed into the PSAC system.

Submission Instructions

1. Please note artists will not be meeting with the selection panel in person. Artists are required to drop work off and leave it on site for assessment by the panel.
2. Choose a submission drop off date (please see reverse page for calendar of dates).
3. Complete the submission form in full including a complete price list, which includes commission (e.g. selling price). If the form has not been completed then the work will be rejected.
4. Submit a maximum of three examples of artworks, accompanied by the completed submission form. These **MUST BE** the completed artworks that are planned for display. The inclusion of photographs or other supporting information is permitted. A higher maximum applies to some art forms/crafts.
5. All submissions must be original work by the submitting artist.
6. Please ensure you do not label your individual items with contact details (this includes address, phone numbers, email or website). Staff will be required to remove this kind of identification.

You will be advised of the selection outcome by phone from a member of staff from Pepper Street Arts Centre, usually within 48 hours of the meeting date.



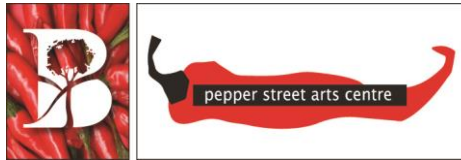

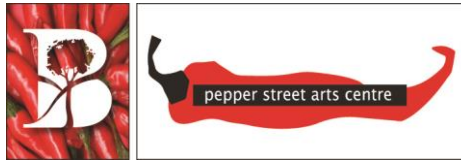
