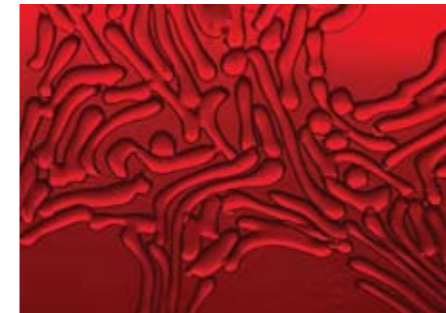

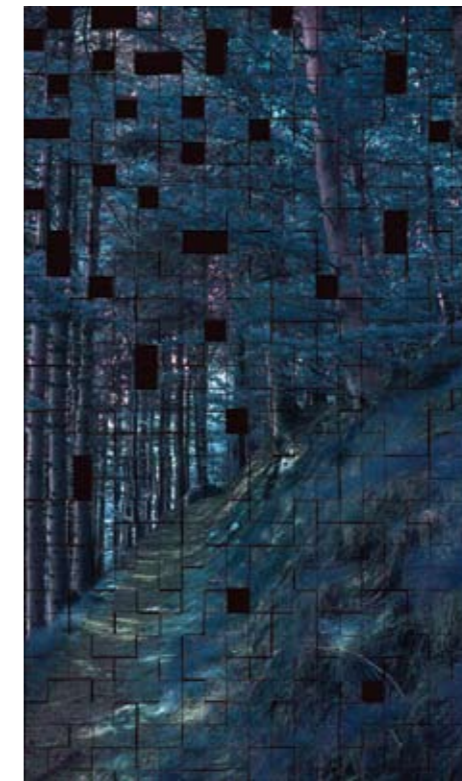
An Exhibition of works by Petra Troyn & Alysha Mallia

Alysha Mallia, Pathway

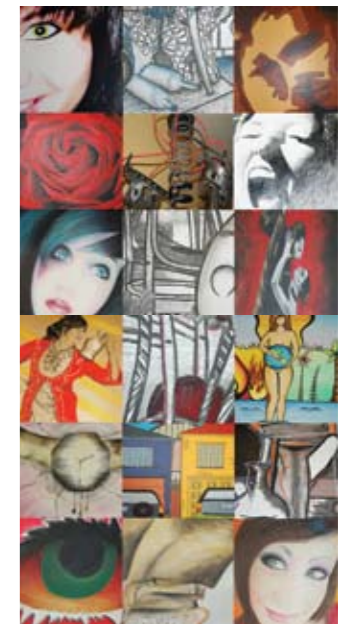
Alysha on the other hand, in her unique photographic works, explores ideas of self identity and the process of cultural change & how experiences, perceptions, reflections & integrations influence this.

## Artist of the Month October

Helen Hedding - "Handmaid" Designs



"I like to make things that make people smile. Be it a handbag, fabric toy or wheat bag I like what I make to create a feeling of happiness in its owner.

With a BA in Fashion Design I worked in fashion and textiles until I established my own one off designer handbag business. Having always loved fabrics, working so closely with top end textiles from all over the world rekindled my need to create. With a sewing mother and a father in textiles, there really was no getting away from it.

The business has travelled with me over the past 5 years during which I have been located in remote mining towns. Even out in the bush women have need of a new handbag!

More recently I have started to branch out into children's clothing & toys. By nature of the fabrics I use being mostly scraps, & with my preference for the use of rough templates over patterns, most things are genuine one offs within a range of ideas.

I love coming up with new products. There is never enough time to do it all! It's great that people in hand crafts are now being recognised. No longer do we have to hand-sew, knit or crochet behind closed doors in fear of being labelled a little kooky!"

## Artist of the Month November

23 October - 24 November  
Fran Kernich - Ceramics



"My latest body of work revisits a long-standing fascination with crystalline glazes & their formulation. The crystals are grown within the glaze by careful manipulation of the kiln temperature during the period when the glaze surface, while still molten, is no longer fluid.

This can take many hours of holding and dropping of the temperature to grow crystals of a good size. Different metallic salts provide the basis for an expansive colour palate of crystalline glazes, which can include contrasting background and crystal colours. Crystal growth is quite random and the chance results make every kiln opening an exciting event.

I like to keep the shape and form of these wheel-thrown pieces relatively simple as I feel this complements the often very complex dendritic, floral or stellar formations on the surface. Some glazes can give the illusion that the pot could be glass, while with others the piece can look like polished agate.

I hope you enjoy my range of work on display!"
