Artist of the Month May

Silk Painting with Jean Winter



"My aim in art is to express colour and the definition of an image. I use silk and inks to recreate the world I see, the energy of life that surrounds me.

I love the Australian landscape – its terrain, wildlife, wildflowers and people. The silk material with which I work has a softness and a sheen, a fragility while at the same time strength and durability.

My work on silk incorporates a technique called serti-gutta. Once the outline is drawn the colours emerge within the outline, absorbing into the silk producing an intense brightness. The interplay of colours is always surprising, creating another perspective.

I have a mental illness. This illness that challenges me everyday also gives me the ability to see life in an altered manner. While I don't understand it, I know that it gives me insights that I wouldn't have otherwise. My disability has become an ability. The final artwork is the result of who I am, where I have been, circumstances and life.

The greatest joy after the work is complete is the delight it brings to others, bringing their own perspective to it and taking my art to another level."
