The State Heritage listed Burnside Ballroom offers a spacious ground floor and mezzanine level, two bar areas (one upstairs and one downstairs), and a well-equipped kitchen. The venue features a stage, with seating booths around the perimeter of the dance floor. Banquet seating and trestle tables can also be supplied.

History

The State Government's Heritage Places Database lists the Ballroom as "an excellent example of a 1950s interior demonstrating characteristics of a modernist design. There are no other known examples of this style of civic interior intact".

Features

Built in 1954, the Burnside Ballroom offers a spacious ground floor and mezzanine level, entrance foyer, ladies' powder rooms and gentlemen's cloak rooms, bar areas on both levels and a well-equipped ground floor commercial kitchen and bar area.

The venue also features 50s style booth seating and tables along the eastern and western walls. It has additional seating capacity for 350 chairs and 17 trestle tables.

The Ballroom caters for a range of performance events, and features a raised stage area, separate green room, excellent PA system and extremely effective air-conditioning.

Whiteboard, portable projector and screen are available upon request.
