# Update-Brown Hill Keswick Creeks Stormwater Project in the South Park Lands

This letter is to update you on the stormwater management project that is being undertaken by the Brown Hill and Keswick Creeks Stormwater Board in the South Park Lands.

Over the coming months you will start to see construction work occurring in the South Park Lands as the wetland project commences in Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi (Park 16).

### What have we done so far?

Since late last year the detailed design for the wetland has been finalised, and we have been engaging with a range of stakeholders as we prepare for construction. The information provided by stakeholders has been invaluable in understanding how the South Park Lands are used and enjoyed and how we can best manage the construction. We have also established a database of contacts that we will update regularly and use to communicate with all stakeholders about the wetland project. A postcard flyer has recently been distributed to people who live or work near the wetland project area, which provides information about the works and how they can join our contact list. In this way, we can keep in touch, providing the latest information about the wetland project.

## What is happening next?

The main construction of the wetland is anticipated to commence later this year (November) and will take about 12 months to complete. Some early works to be undertaken in the months of August / September involve the removal of the stand of poplar trees in the south east corner of Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi (Park 16) as these works are best done at this time of year.
