### Community Land Revocations

Council worked with our community to save Constable Hyde Memorial Garden. Council moved to revoke community land classification of the land on which stand Rose Park Preschool and JB Cleland Kindergarten.

The land on which the Rose Park Scout Hall and the Gurney Road Garden (41 Grant Avenue) stand will remain community land.

This decision now allows Council to proceed to negotiate the acquisition of Constable Hyde Memorial Gardens, saving it for our community.

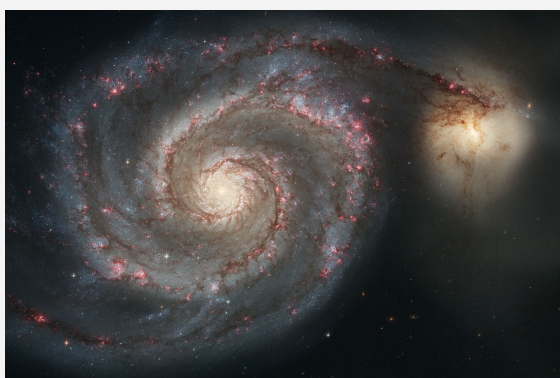
## Meet the Author

## Astronomy and Stargazing

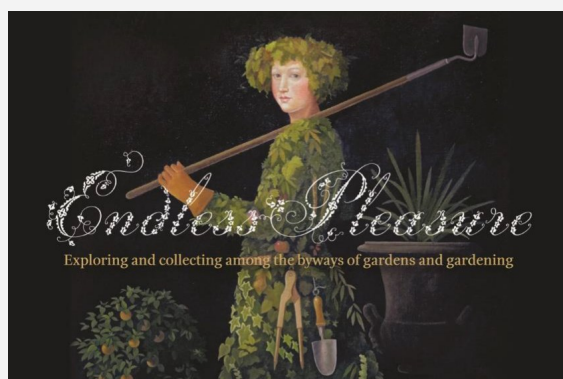
Have you ever gazed up at the night sky and wondered what mysteries lay within the darkness?

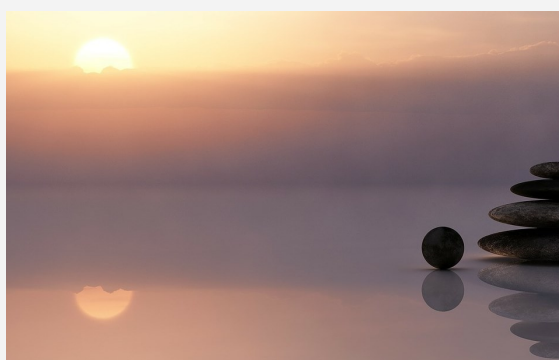

## Summer Fire Prevention

Get ready for the pending Fire Danger Season now. Slash or mow long grass and remove cut material (unless it can rot down before summer). Remove weeds and cut back trees overhanging your home. Remove low hanging vegetation, fallen branches and other debris especially leaves from gutters. Check and service all mechanical equipment, including grass cutters, water pumps, sprinkler systems and fire extinguishers. Prepare and check your emergency kit. Review, update and practise your Bushfire Survival Plan.

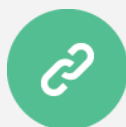
