

Waste to Landfill

YOUR 140 LITRE WASTE (RED LID) BIN WILL BE COLLECTED WEEKLY. ITEMS PLACED IN THIS BIN WILL BE SENT TO LANDFILL.



All general household waste that cannot be put into recycling (yellow lid) or organics (green lid) bins.

- ✓ Plastic bags, garbage bags and non-recyclable plastic and food packaging e.g. chip packets
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Kitty litter (wrapped)
- ✓ Video tapes
- ✓ Small broken household items such as crockery and glassware (including light globes)
- ✓ Cling film and wine bladders
- ✓ Rags and clothing that cannot be passed on as hand-me-downs or given to charity shops
- ✓ Polystyrene foam (including meat trays and cups)
- ✓ Ropes, hoses and strapping
- ✓ Deceased animals

- ✗ Timber
- ✗ Bricks/rubble

- ✗ Batteries
